03

MEET YOUR DENTIST

You'll then meet your dentist, who will take the time to get to know you, understand your dental concerns, and make you feel at ease before beginning your examination

DENTAL EXAM

Your dentist will then carry out a full examination, checking your teeth, gums, and overall oral health — and answering any questions along the way

05

SPECIAL TESTS

If needed, we can carry out extra tests like X-rays, photos, or a quick digital scan with our iTero scanner — all done during the same visit to help us get a clearer picture of your oral health

06

TREATMENT PLAN

We will thoroughly discuss all findings with you and explain any recommended treatments, reviewing all available options to help you make an informed decision

By Bus:
